## DEVELOPMENT AT RAVENSWOOD

Archadia are delighted to be working with the charity Norwood to develop their site at Ravenswood to create new facilities for residents and the public that will include the best in design for disability.

Ravenswood was set up in 1953 by four families aiming to provide education and care for their children and for others with a learning disability. It is now home to over 100 people with learning disabilities living in registered care homes and supported housing set in over 120 acres of Berkshire countryside.

The development will provide brand-new fully accessible homes and ancillary infrastructure ensuring the delivery of outstanding support to current and future residents.

Construction will commence in 2019 with completion in 2021.

#### ROOF ON AT BEECHWOOD GROVE

Site works are well underway and the new extra-care housing scheme in Caversham designed for A2 Dominion is taking shape. Archadia are working closely with Feltham Construction and completion is due in September this year. Beechwood Grove will provide 43 flats for older people with an onsite care provider and 16 of the 43 homes will be available for social rent to help alleviate the shortage of affordable homes in the area. The scheme will also provide communal facilities including a cafe and hair salon which will be available to both residents and local people.
